CALL FOR ART SUBMISSIONS

Outright International welcomes you to submit your artwork for display in our New York City headquarters! The theme we are highlighting is **Celebrating Joy in Queer Community**. We want pieces that center the love, energy, and vibrancy of our LGBTIQ people across the globe. Outright is embarking on this project because we believe all forms of activism are vital to building a strong movement, and art and creativity are very much a part of that. We want to help ensure that the artists in our movement have their work seen so they can engage and impact as many people as possible. Thank you for giving us that opportunity.

- We are asking for 2D art that can be hung on a wall. Please do not submit sculptures or 3D pieces.
- Your submission piece should be something you have already made – we are not asking for custom pieces. We want to show what you already have!
- Art should be sent in a digital format as either a JPG or PNG image. Selected pieces should be high resolution and enlargeable to at least 24x24 inches / 60x60 centimeters.
- Outright will print and frame all selected pieces.

If your piece is chosen, you will receive **750 USD** for your work, and it will be featured on Outright's social media channels!

- Title your file with Your Name, Outright Art, and file type. Example: **YourNameOutrightArt.jpg**
- Please include your preferred name and pronouns in the body of the email.
- If you prefer to submit art anonymously, please write "Anonymous" in any place where you would have written your name.

- We strongly encourage you to also include an artist's statement and social media channels in the body of your email.
- The artist's statement should be no more than **500 words** describing what inspires you to make your art, your methodology, and how you feel your work relates to the LGBTIQ experience/community. Please feel free to write it in the language you are most comfortable with.
